New York Bar Exam

- In many countries there is only one national bar exam, in the U.S. each state has its own bar exam
- The New York Bar Exam is the most popular bar exam for international lawyers, and includes several exams and additional steps:
  - New York Law Exam
  - Universal Bar Exam (UBE)
  - Additional requirements for admission to the New York Bar:
    - Completion of first law degree prior to receiving LL.M.
    - 24 credit LL.M. program
    - Advanced determination of eligibility by New York State Board of Bar
