French B2: DELF/DALF or any other recognized international test, a certificate from the Alliance Française, or an institutional letter certifying the student's French proficiency; an online French test may be administered after nomination.

- List of potential courses of interest:** (approximately 4-7 courses)
- Proof of citizenship:** A copy of student's valid passport (not a national identity card).
- Signed Privacy Notice Statement:** a copy of the [Privacy notice statement for Non-Canadians](#) signed by the candidate and dated within the last six months



Letter of intent from the candidate:

- Addressed to the university that the student is applying
- No more than one-page long
- In English for LU and COTR; in French for UQTR.
- Explain the nature of studies to be undertaken
- Provide the reason for study in Canada
- Provide justification for why the student chose the institution to which he or she is applying.
- Indicate the program the student is in and how studying in Canada for a semester will relate to his or her future career.

Letter of proof of full-time enrolment from the home institution:

- On official letterhead
- Dated within the last six months
- Confirms that the candidate is currently enrolled in a full-time program.
- Note: If this letter is in a language other than English, please provide a translation.
- Note: Copies of transcripts, a student card or a letter of admission are not acceptable.
- **Request at the Registration window** and specify the letter requirements when making the request.

Letter of support from the home institution:

- Addressed to the university that the student is applying
- No more than one-page long
- In English
- On official letterhead
- Dated within the last six months
- **From the candidate's program director**
- Explains the nature of study to be undertaken in Canada and how the candidate and the home institution will benefit from this scholarship program

- Have completed the equivalent of a minimum of one year of full-time courses in your program of enrollment and have completed a total of 13 years of schooling for undergraduate programs.
- Have found a UQTR study program that corresponds to the program you enrolled in at your home university on the list attached in the email or based on bilateral agreements.
- Have an excellent academic level
- Be fluent in French (CECR level B2, intermediate-advanced);
